

Thirteen from Youth Decide to be Baptized

Baptism is one of Jesus' two *ordinances*, the other being the Last Supper. As such, thirteen Christians from the Youth Ministry chose obedience by deciding to be baptized.



By God's grace, after a short baptismal lecture, they were baptized on May 10, 2009, witnessed by many NCF members.

Most of these young people were already believers for years, while some of them accepted Jesus Christ in NCF's summer camp a few weeks ago. According to Pastor Kirby Figueras, who handled the baptismal lecture, some were even

Another testimony is that of Richard Quiano, who contemplated the thought of finally being baptized after the camp. He was later joined by some, "though we were quite few at that time," says Richard. Later, they invited other young Christians with them who were not yet baptized, and the Lord's blessing made them a huge bunch of thirteen.

These people, young as they are, are a good testimony, not only in the eyes of those who weren't yet baptized, but also in the eyes of God.
