

Men's Fellowship Starts in NCF

Last February 27, the newly founded Men's Fellowship began their Saturday morning with a sumptuous breakfast at Novaliches Christian Fellowship Main.

The meeting began early at seven and was filled with worship and sharing time over cups of coffee.

"It was fun, but time simply flew fast," said Brother Justy Guzman, a Music Ministry member and one of its founding members.

"It gives a nice feeling that we got to know each other and we, men of God, are interacting in this church."

Pastor Mark Dantes, who was also a member, exhorted on the role of men within the church and the community to the 12 attendees.

He quoted 2 Timothy 2:13, "If we are faithless, He will remain faithful, for He cannot disown Himself." He was also glad at the eagerness and the encouraging atmosphere among the brethren.

The idea for a Men's Fellowship in NCF came after a Worker's Meeting last year, when brethren including Brother Justy, Oscar Alabado and Fernan Palting saw the need to gather the elder gentlemen who desire to lend their strength and service to the Lord.

After vigorous promotions last January, they finally kicked off their very first breakfast fellowship.

They are currently inviting members ages 30 and above for single men, and ages 25 and above for the married ones.
