

Pastor Arnel Visits NCF

Coming all the way from his missionary work in Gabon, Africa, Pastor Arnel Pascual has once again visited NCF this Sunday, November 8.

He told the congregation that it was the Lord's calling that he should go back home to the Philippines. It was quite a while since his last visit back in February. Furthermore, he passes the gratitude of those in their congregation

who received Bibles from NCF; it was considered a big help considering the cost of Bibles back in Gabon, where churches have been planted, particularly in the capital city of Libreville. Including the congregation that Pastor Arnel handled were around 40 Filipinos.

Moving to the preaching, the missionary tackled on the Seed of Multiplication, hailing from the time of the Creation, and having its quality maintained by the redemption through Jesus Christ. He exhorted the congregation that, as Christians, the seed in us does reproduce, among them being blessings, which should not be kept for ourselves but rather be shared, by which way we would plant new seeds.

After his visits to his loved ones and a few other churches, Pastor Arnel is set to leave on the 25th to return to Gabon Africa. He asks for prayers for their missionary work and their congregation there, as well as for the plans to further extend the mission territory to Taiwan or Peru. Furthermore, he also asks for prayers concerning their health, for, as he puts it in his words, "It is God who always gives us strength."
