

NCF Christmas Gift-Giving to Communities

It seems folks in Novaliches found the Christmas breeze quite early as Novaliches Christian Fellowship distributed Christmas packages to 35 families last December 11.

Of the recipients, 25 families were from the surrounding communities of Korokan and Sampalukan, and 10 were from Forest Hills Subdivision, all in Northern Quezon City.

The Christmas packages included bags of groceries, clothes, rice and other necessities, yet the families were not only recipients of material blessings. The Word of God was spread through preaching and prayer, of which they are in dire need, said NCF Senior Pastor Mark Dantes.

“They are thirsty – both physically and spiritually. We pray for God’s continuous work among them through the Word,” said Pastor Dantes as he emphasized the need to help communities beyond their financial and material welfare.

NCF ministers to the Korokan and Sampalukan communities through missionary work and a monthly Feeding Program.

Of the three communities, only those in Forest Hills were devastated by Typhoon Ondoy last September 2009. NCF lent – and still lends a hand regularly as they continue rebuilding their lives, from last year’s reconstruction work to relief goods and other packages.
