

NCF Bible Institute Welcomes New Students

As millions of school-age kids nationwide trooped back to their schools, the NCF Bible Institute saw an influx of enrollees in its Basic Bible Course offering as it reopened last June 29, 2010.



Ten men and five ladies make up the total of 15 students who decided to grow in their knowledge of God and His Word. All but one lady were from NCF Banaba, five of the men were from Pangarap Village Southern Baptist Church, four were from NCF Main, while one was from Baptist Church Tungko.a

The youngest enrollee is in first year college at a secular school while the eldest is a realtor/ businessman. Interestingly enough, while one student is seeking reinstatement into the Philippine National Police service, another one is gearing to apply at the same agency, being a fresh graduate of Criminology in college. Still, the fifth oldest currently enrolled is the lay pastor of a church not affiliated with NCF, but sought to study based on the recommendation of Pastor Noni Lazo, himself being just a recent graduate of the NCF Bible Institute. Only one though is enrolled in all the subjects.



All were in deep thought as they delved into Bibliology, the subject matter of General Theology I. Others were getting to be enlightened as they started discussing the Theology of the Cults under Pastor Mark Dantes. Some began learning about Personal Evangelism and Methods of Bible Study from Pastor Melvin Pascual, while two others started getting an English refresher course under Ms. Dang Baldonado.

The first trimester is until September 21, 2010. Each subject consists of three units with three hours per period, a total of 36 hours for the whole of 12 weeks.

Hopefully, each one will live out 2 Timothy 2:15, the theme verse of the school. "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth."
