

## NCF: Helping Hands after Ondoy Disaster

The Novaliches Christian Fellowship has also extended its hand in helping flood victims after Typhoon Ondoy's advent in the Philippines on September 26-28 left many communities flooded, especially in the Luzon provinces and in Metro Manila.
