

Ladies Work in QC Circle Tract Distribution

The Ladies Fellowship commits to newer harvest grounds as they marched their way for tract distribution into the Quezon City Circle Grounds on February 28, 2009.

That Saturday team of eight was composed of Sisters Sophia Ga, Linda Garcia, Josie Malijao, Bella Figueras, Divine Victorio, Maricris Covar, Baby Biglang-awa and Del Gagto.

The team not only distributed tracts; topical verses from the Bible are also included. The whole-day distribution reached many, especially from the youth, most notable among these were a band of students from the University of the Philippines.



Says Sis. Del: "Maraming nagpapasalamat na tao!" ("Many were very grateful!")

The distribution of tracts was not only a blessing for the grateful recipients, but also for the distributors as well. The experience was reflected in their testimonies:

"Natutuwa kami sa mga tumatanggap ng tracks. Pag-abot namin sa kanila, binabasa kaagad...mga bata at binatilyo, nag-uunahan pa sila; sila na mismo ang humihingi ng tracts." ("The tracts were immediately read after we gave it to them... kids and young people, they were so eager, they're actually rushing for these...they themselves were the ones asking for tracts...") says Sis. Linda.

Another blessing to the team was claimed by Sis. Divine: "Talagang napakaganda kapag nakakapagbigay ka ng mga babasahin. Talagang nakakagaan ng loob; nakakasunod ka sa utos ng Diyos. Maski antok na antok na ako, hindi hadlang para makapagbahagi ng salita ng Diyos." ("It's really good when you can give tracts. It's really uplifting deep inside; you are following God's commandments. Even the lethargy I previously felt was no obstacle in sharing God's Word.")

Considering the warm reception and the number of recipients, the track distribution can be counted as yet another successful sharing of the Gospel.
