

Youth Choir Begins Training

Nineteen members of NCF Main's youth group *Clayhouse* tested the mettle of their voices in choir training last January 31.

The session was handled by Music Ministry head Gigi Dantes, who was impressed at the good start, despite the new trainees still struggling to learn the basic rudiments of choral singing.



“They did very well as beginners,” said Sis. Gigi, after the first rehearsal. “It’s all about honing skills – the choir is the avenue that will tweak the musical ability of the youth, in tone, tempo, and blending.”

The idea came to her and Pastor Kirby Figueras of *Clayhouse*, whom she consulted for a schedule earlier this January.



Many of the youth were assigned to the sopranos and tenors, but the lower-pitched altos and basses are also faring well.

Sis. Gigi adds that this endeavor is in anticipation of the Christmas cantata preparations that will commence in August.

Regular sessions run from 5:00 to 7:00 pm every Sunday. Renditions will be every last Sunday of the month during worship.
